 Position serves primarily as Pediatric Nurse Practitioner / Primary Care Provider for the TAT Health Care System / Elbowoods Memorial Health Center. The Pediatric Nurse Practitioner is responsible for performing advance practice sessions within the scope of his/her license and training.

a) Job Summary – under CMO supervision

- i) Conduct comprehensive history and physical examinations.
- ii) Establish medical assessment for acute/chronic health problems and develop care plans. Plans will include objective testing, medications, and consultant services.
- iii) Order, perform, and interpret laboratory tests.
- iv) Perform procedures as per demonstrated competence and privileges.
- v) Provide urgent care: PNP will have current ALS, ACLS, PALS, and will provide primary intervention until EMS arrives.
- vi) PNP functions in accordance with the Pediatric Nurse Practitioner Certification Act.
- 2) Represents TAT Health Care Centers in a highly professional manner.
- 3) Establishes positive communications with all departments of EMHC to assure stable operations.
- 4) Demonstrates respect and understanding of confidentiality for patients, staff and others according to policy and HIPAA regulation.
