POSITION SUMMARY: (position includes but is not limited to the following):

- Provides compassionate services as necessary to fulfill professional and patient care obligations. Physician will perform duties as are usual and customary for primary care physicians in the community.
- Utilize personal and team skills to care for and welcome patients, clients, guests and co-workers as stated in the mission of Elbowoods Memorial Health Center and manifests in all aspects of their role the core values as defined by EMHC.
 - Community a coming together of people who commit themselves to a mission, caring for and challenging each other to use their personal gifts and skills to serve.
 - Respect giving and showing reverence, esteem and consideration for self and others.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Frequent exposure to patients and employees (co-workers, providers and administration).
- Potential exposure to blood and other hazardous material, communicable diseases, and other conditions common to a clinic environment.
- Primarily involves standing, walking, pushing and pulling, manual dexterity, auditory and visual acuity, REQUIRED.
- Work is performed in an office environment with varying conditions of noise level, temperature, and illumination.
- Work a hectic schedule and long hours.
- Occasionally lifts up to 50 pounds of material.
- Requires eye-hand coordination and manual dexterity sufficient to operate keyboard, computer and other office equipment.
- Work situations may be stressful and require irregular hours.
